Student Personal Laptop Policy

This policy is for students who wish to bring their personal laptop or netbook to use in the school environment for internet access using the Cleveland City Schools' wireless network. This policy does not include iPod Touch, iPad, or similar electronic devices that are covered under the new Board policy. It does not cover smart phones as they are classified as cellular and currently not permitted. Use of these items in the classroom will be subject to the individual teacher's vision of incorporation into their instructional program.

There are three requirements for using these electronic devices in the Cleveland City Schools.

First, you must have a current antivirus subscription.

Second, you agree to use the wireless network provided in your school for connectivity and not try to go around the content filters by using proxy servers, broadband cards or other cellular connectivity devices while you are at school.

Note: Violations of the Children's Internet Protection Act could result in the loss of the funds for the school system that we use to purchase our internet access.

Third, you agree not to bring or share objectionable content on your laptop.

Violation of the terms of this agreement will result in revocation of the right to bring your electronic device to access the wireless network and possible further disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by your building principal.
